## Corrections are marked in red.

Red Fabric cut 1 strip 2 1/8" x wof (centre of log cabin blocks)

cut 4 strips 3" x wof cut 2 strips into 4 – 17½ strips (inner border)

cut 2 strips into 4 – 18¾ strips (inner border)

Dark Green Fabric Cut 16 - 3½" squares (snowball blocks)

Cut 2 strips 4" x wof, sub-cut into (16) 4" squares (B) (maple leaf blocks HST)

Cream Fabric Cut 8 – 4" x 6½" rectangles (Snow ball Blocks)

Cut  $16 - 3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles (Snow ball blocks) Cut  $16 - 3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" rectangles (Snow ball blocks)

Cut 2 strips 4" x wof , sub cut into (16) 4" squares (B) (maple leaf blocks HST)

Black or Brown Fabric Cut 4 - 3" x 2½" rectangle, fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, press.

Log Cabin blocks - #5 - blocks should measure 81/2"

## Add inner border

- 1. Sandwich folded black 3" x 2%" rectangle between 2 17%" red strips. Sew using a scant %", set seam and press, lining up fold line with seam line. Make 2; sew to either side of log cabin centre.
- 2. Sandwich folded black  $3'' \times 2\%''$  rectangle between 2 18%'' red strips. Sew using a scant %'', set seam and press lining up fold line with seam line.

## Snowball Tree Blocks





- 1. Fold 3½" green square wrong sides together on the diagonal and press.
- 2. Sandwich between 1 4" x 6½" and 3¼" x 6½" cream rectangles, matching raw edges of one side with raw edges of cream rectangles. Sew using a scant ¼" seam; set seam. Press flat, matching fold line on dark green fabric with the seam line of the background. Make 8 (figure 8).
- 3. Fold 4 5" green leaf fabric squares, wrong sides together, on the diagonal and press. Using 4 blocks from above, place the folded 5" squares onto the **right** side of tree strip set, matching raw edges of one side with raw edge of tree strip set. Place a 34"x 6½" cream rectangle over top of each, matching raw edges.
- 5. Mirror image snowball block Fold the remaining 4 5" green leaf fabric squares, wrong sides together, on the diagonal and press. Sandwich the folded 5" square onto the **left** side of tree strip. Place a 3½" x 6½" cream rectangle over top, matching raw edges. Sew, set seam and press as in Step #2. Trim off excess fabrics as you did in log cabin centre (figure 10).
- 6. Sandwich a 4" folded black strip between one 4" and one 3\%" cream squares. Sew, set seam, and press open matching the fold line with the seam. Add second 4" fold black strip in the same manner (figure 11). Make 8.
- 7. Sew the trunk strips to the bottom of the tree top strips. Make 8. Square up to 9½".

## Maple Leaf blocks

- 1. Make 16 HST
- #4. Square up to 9½" (square up from the stem sides only)
